

Thematic Priority Civil Security for Society with ~341 million euros is among the smallest thematic priorities


Latvia at the moment have no projects within this area


Civil Security for Society Work Programme 2023

Cluster 3 specifics

- Beneficiaries, when written in the Topic text, have to include endusers in the consortium, or so-called practitioners (police authorities, border guards, first responders, operators of critical infrastructure, firefighters, civil protection, etc.).
- The involvement of practitioners has proven its value, ensuring that the results of the projects meet the needs of the end-users.
- It is fundamental importance and **represents an additional eligibility criteria**, non-compliance makes the proposal ineligible for funding.
- The details are described in the "conditions of the call" section of the Work Program.

Security appraisal

Only proposals above threshold are considered for funding

- Security Scrutiny Procedure (SSP) is carried out in the following cases:
 - Automatically, if the proposal has been submitted under a topic flagged as security sensitive;
 - In other cases, if the Security Screening has concluded that the proposal is very likely to raise security issues for which mitigation measures should be proposed.
- Objective:
 - identify security concerns and verify they have been properly addressed by the applicant
 - assess if **sensitive or classified information** will be used or produced
 - propose recommendations in order to properly address the identified security issues.

Purpose: to assess and address potential misuse of project results (e.g. results that could be channeled into crime or terrorism).




Security Review

Latvian Council of Science

The Security Review includes three steps:

- 1. The **Security Pre-screening** carried out by qualified staff of the granting authority, during the scientific evaluation or soon after;
- 2. The Security Screening performed by qualified staff of the European Commission (DG HOME), after the scientific evaluation and before the signature of the Grant Agreement;
- 3. The Security Scrutiny conducted by the Security Scrutiny Group, comprised of national security experts, after the scientific evaluation and before the signature of the Grant Agreement.


