




EIC WHO CAN APPLY & WHAT FOR?

PATHFINDER

Consortia of at least 3
different independent legal
entities established in at least
3 different eligible countries.
Additionally, single applicants or
small consortia (2 partners) for EIC
Pathfinder Challenges only.



Grants of up to €3 million (open) or €4 million (challenges, or more if duly justified, to achieve the proof of principle and validate the scientific basis of breakthrough technology (Technology Readiness Levels 1-4)







TRANSITION


Grants of up to €2.5 million to validate and demonstrate technology in application-relevant environment (Technology Readiness Levels 4 to 5/6) and develop market readiness.





Grants for up to €2.5 million for developing your innovation (TRL 5/6 to 8)
Investments of €0.5 up to €15 million in the form of direct equity or convertible loans for scaling up your innovation and attracting coinvestors

The applicants must be establishes in a Member State or Horizon Europe Associated country



EIC ACCELERATOR

Single start-ups and SMEs (including spinouts), individuals (intending to launch a start-up/SME) and in exceptional cases small mid-caps (fewer than 499 employees)



The technology component of the innovation is at least TRL 5 (technology validated in relevant environment)





EIC BUSINESS ACCELERATOR PROCESS

Step 1



IDEA PRESENTATION

- Applicants have a disruptive / deep tech idea with a potential to scale up. Submissions of short proposals are possible at any time. Evaluation by remote evaluators within 4 -6 weeks.
- Proposal template of 12 pages, 3 min video, 10 pitch ppt



Step 2

SUBMISSION

- Successful step 1 applicants submit their full proposal to regular cut-off deadlines, to be assessed by remote evaluators.
- To help you draft your full proposal, you will be entitled to receive 3 days of remote coaching from the EIC Business Acceleration Services.

• Next step: 3 GOs

Step 3



PITCH

- Successful Step 2 applicants will pitch their innovation in front of EIC Jury Members. If selected, applicants will be awarded funding.
- If not selected, applicants will be awarded a Seal of Excellence to help you secure funding from other sources as well as get support from EIC Business Acceleration Services.



EIT Funding per Area (EUR, 2022)




Latvia received a total of **EUR 2.34 million** in EIT grants in 2022.* This amount is EUR 0.77 million higher than the funding received in 2021 and it was directed to Latvian organisations via eight EIT Knowledge and Innovation Communities in 2022. The largest share (EUR 1.42 million) was dedicated to higher education related activities. The funding included EUR 0.96 million to support Latvian SMEs, mainly under EIT Manufacturing and EIT Urban Mobility.


EIT Funding per KIC (EUR, 2022)


EIT COMMUNITY IN LATVIA



In 2021-22:

- 117 Latvian start-ups were supported by the EIT.
- 18 start-ups were created with the support of the EIT in Latvia.
- 48 Latvian women entrepreneurs received support from the EIT.
- EUR 1.29 million investment was attracted by EIT-supported ventures in Latvia.
- 11 EIT-supported innovations were launched on the market.
- 1270+ Latvian participants joined non-labelled education and training by the EIT.




