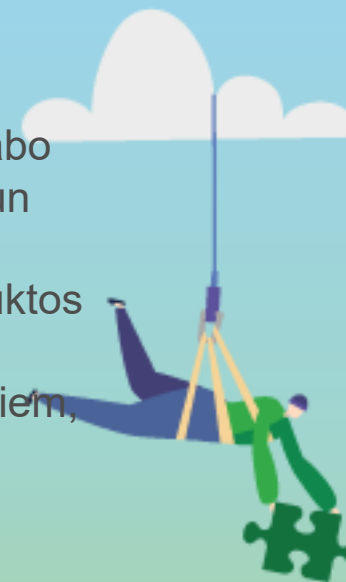

MSCA doktorantūras tīkli īsteno doktorantūras programmas, sadarbojoties universitātēm, pētniecības iestādēm un pētniecības infrastruktūrām, uzņēmumiem, tostarp MVU, un citiem sociālekonomiskajiem dalībniekiem no dažādām valstīm visā Eiropā un ārpus tās. MSCA doktorantūras tīkli ir atvērti arī trešo valstu organizāciju līdzdalībai, lai veicinātu stratēģiskas starptautiskas partnerības pētnieku apmācībai un apmaiņai. Projekta priekšlikumi var atspoguļot esošās vai plānotās pētniecības partnerības starp dalīborganizācijām.

Doktorantu atlases procedūrai jābūt atklātai, pārredzamai un uz nopelniem balstītai saskaņā ar rīcības kodeksu pētnieku pieņemšanai darbā. Paziņojumā par vakanci (ko plaši reklamēs starptautiskā mērogā, tostarp EURAXESS jānorāda, vai publicētās likmes ietver visus darba devēja un darba ņēmēja nodokļus un iemaksas. Ja iespējams, jāpublicē bruto alga (neto alga + darbinieka nodokļi un iemaksas).



MSCA Doctoral Networks EK rekomendē pieteikt Industriālos vai Kopīgos doktorantu tīkla projektus.

Industriālie Doktoranti iziet ārpus akadēmiskajām aprindām un **attīstīs prasmes rūpniecībā un uzņēmējdarbībā**, kopīgi uzraugot akadēmiskās un neakadēmiskās organizācijas, abas var būt vienā un tajā pašā ES dalībvalstī vai Apvārsnis Eiropa asociētajā valstī.

Kopējās Doktorantūras ir ļoti integrēts starptautiskās, starpnozaru un starpdisciplīnu sadarbības veids doktorantūras apmācībā, rezultātā tiek iegūti kopīgi, **divkārši vai vairāki doktora grādi, kas atzīti vismaz vienā ES dalībvalstī vai Horizon Europe asociētajā valstī**.



MSCA Doctoral Network **vajadzētu būt skaidri noteiktai uzraudzības padomei**, kas koordinē visa tīkla apmācības, pētniecības un jo īpaši uzraudzības pasākumus saskaņā ar MSCA uzraudzības pamatnostādņem, vienlaikus izveidojot pastāvīgu saziņu un prakses apmaiņu starp iesaistītajām organizācijām, lai gūtu maksimālu labumu no partnerības.

MSCA Doctoral Networks būtu jāizmanto papildināmība **starp dalīborganizācijām un jāveicina zināšanu apmaiņa un tīklu veidošanas pasākumi**, piemēram, organizējot seminārus un konferences. Ierosinātajiem mācību pasākumiem būtu jāatbilst skaidri noteiktām vajadzībām dažādās pētniecības un inovācijas jomās, attiecīgi atsaucoties uz starpdisciplīnu un daudzdisciplīnu jomām, un jāievēro ES principi par inovatīvu doktorantūras apmācību. **Galvenokārt būtu jākoncentrē uz jaunu zinātnes atziņu attīstīšanu, veicot oriģinālus pētījumus par personalizētiem projektiem.**

Pētnieku starpnozaru nosūtīšana darbā citās dalīborganizācijās, tostarp trešās valstīs, tiek veicināta, ja tas ir saskaņā ar projekta mērķiem. Tas palielinās pētnieku nodarbinātību ārpus akadēmiskajām aprindām.

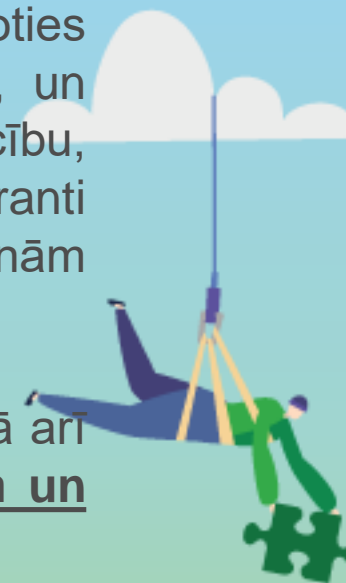


Doktorantūras tīkliem būtu **jāizstrādā būtiski mācību moduļi, tostarp digitāli**, pievēršoties galvenajām nododamajām prasmēm un kompetencēm, kas ir kopīgas visām jomām, un veicinot atklātās zinātnes, inovāciju un uzņēmējdarbības kultūru, kā arī labu zinātnisko rīcību, piemēram, pētniecības integritāti. Jo īpaši doktorantiem būtu pienācīgi jā sagatavo doktoranti (pastiprinātai sadarbībai pētniecības jomā un informācijas apmaiņai, kas iespējama ar jaunām (digitālām) tehnoloģijām).

Īpaša uzmanība tiek pievērsta uzraudzības un darbaudzināšanas pasākumu kvalitātei, kā arī profesionālajai orientācijai. Doktorantu-pētnieku **uzraudzība ir obligāta Industriālajiem un Kopīgajiem doktorantiem.**

Doktorantam **jāizstrādā karjeras attīstības plāns**, šis plāns ietver pētnieka apmācību un karjeras vajadzības, tostarp apmācību par nododamām prasmēm, mācīšanu, publikāciju plānošanu un piedalīšanos konferencēs un pasākumos, kuru mērķis ir pilsoņiem atklāt zinātni un pētniecību.

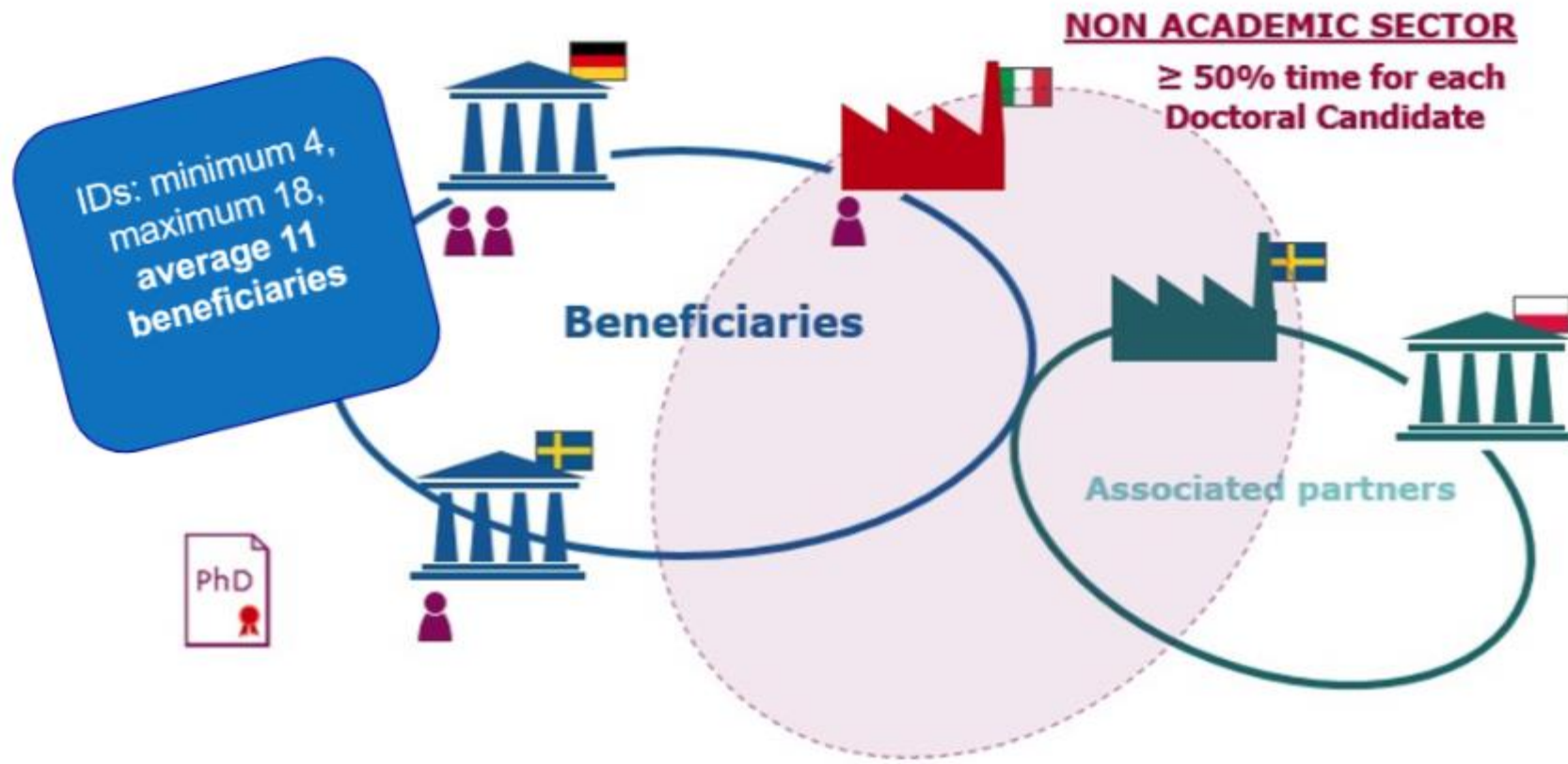

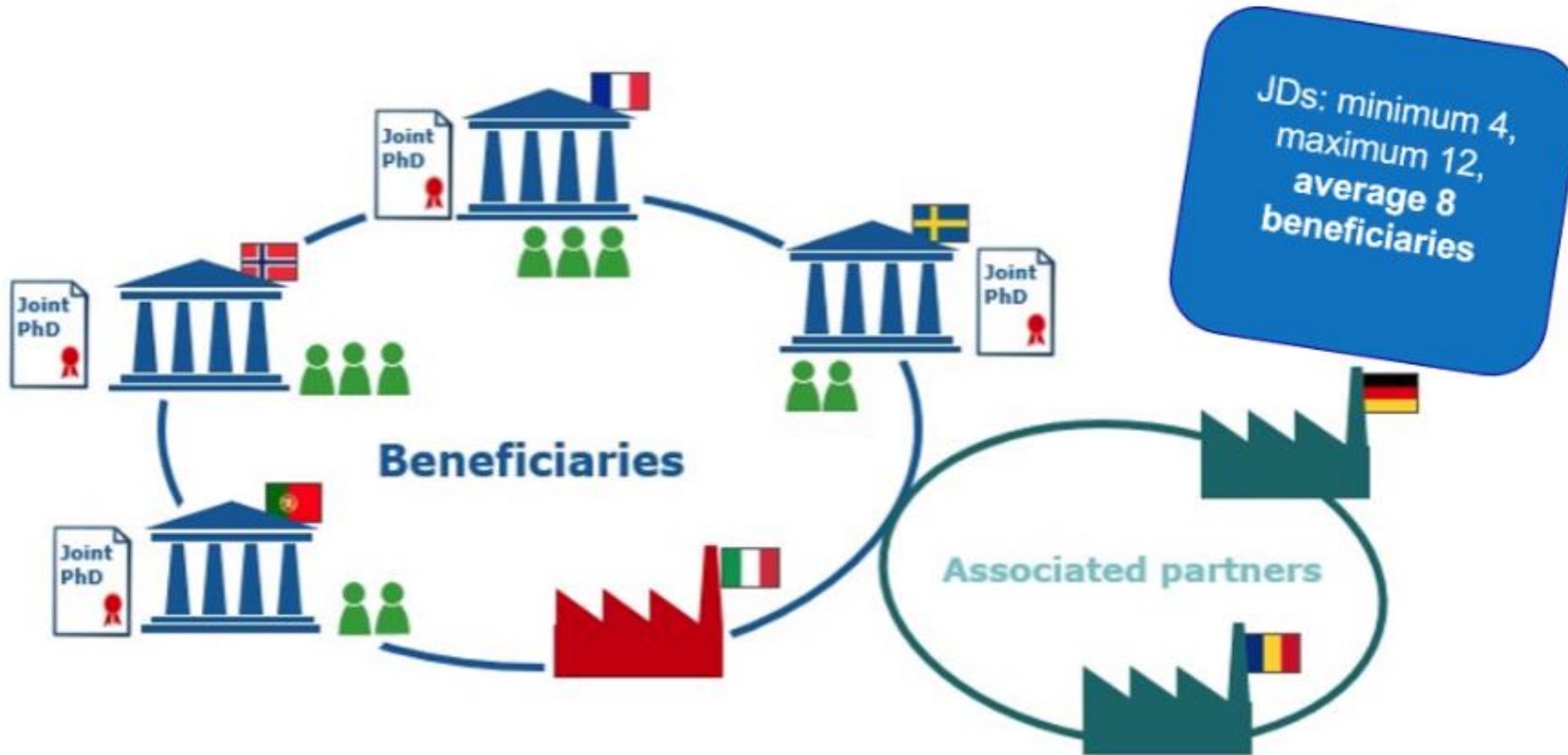
