

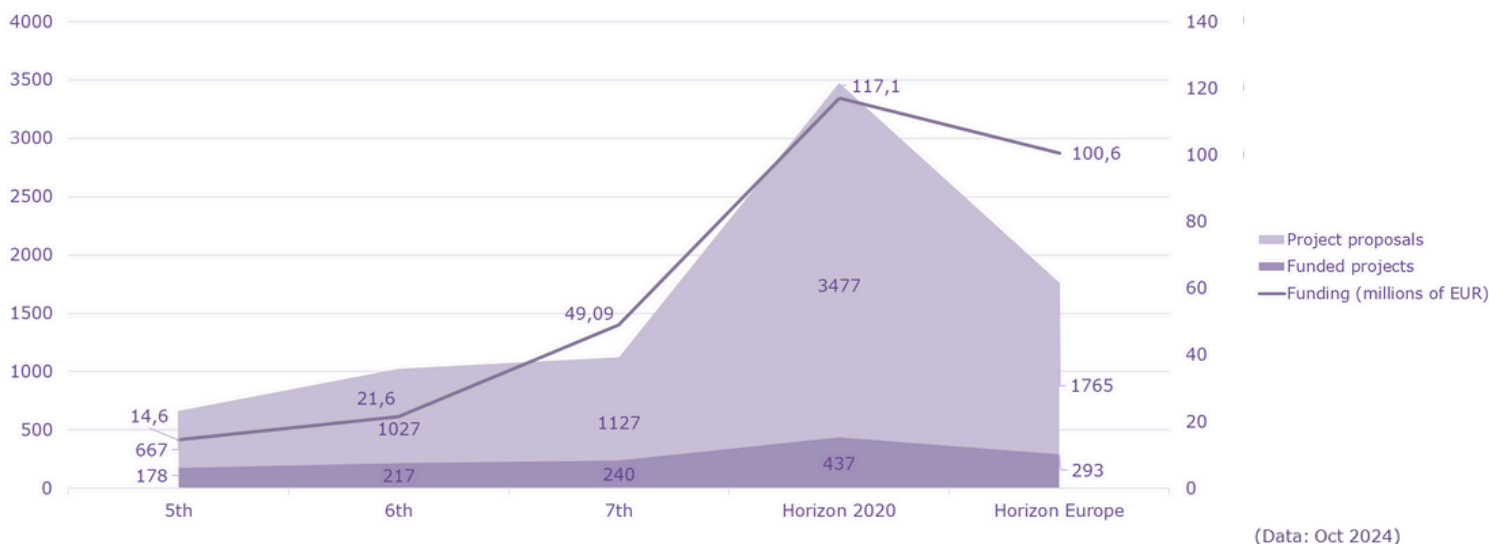
25 YEARS OF LATVIAN PARTICIPATION IN RESEARCH FRAMEWORK PROGRAMMES



On **July 16, 1999**, the **Parliament of Latvia** adopted a law on participation in the **Fifth Framework Programme**.

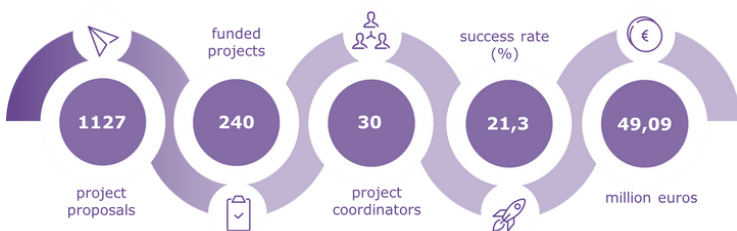
Latvia became a full member of the Fifth Framework Programme starting from **August 1, 1999**.

5TH FRAMEWORK PROGRAMME (1998–2002)

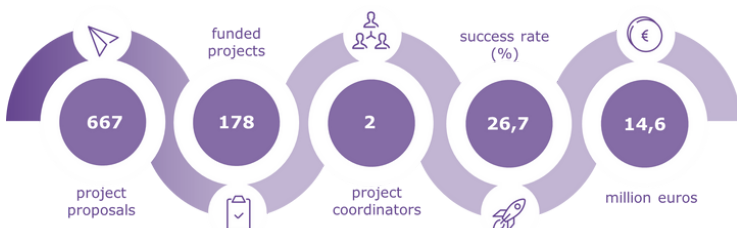

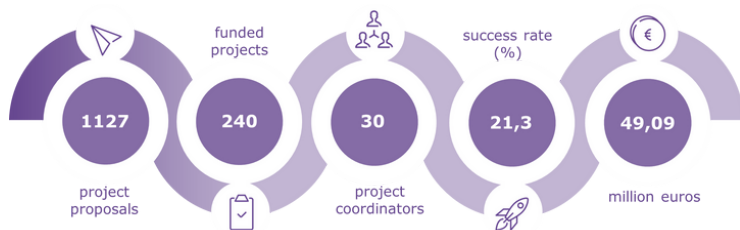

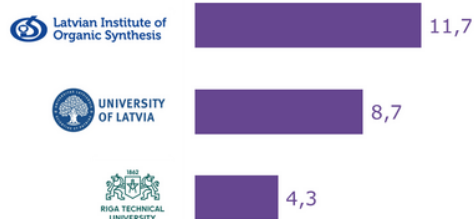

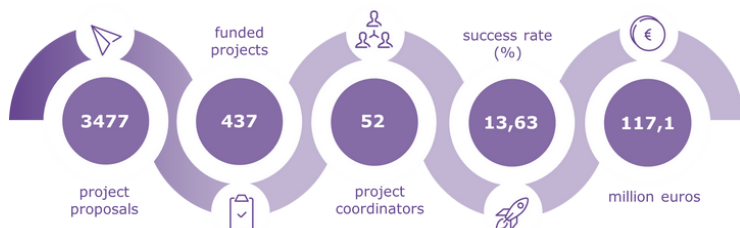

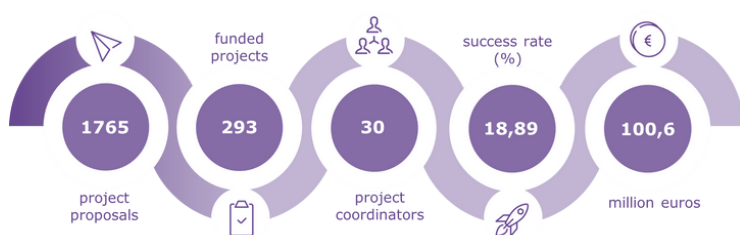
HORIZON 2020 (2014–2020)



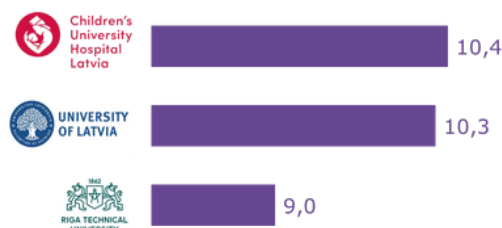
BIGGEST FUNDING FOR LATVIA (millions of EUR)
